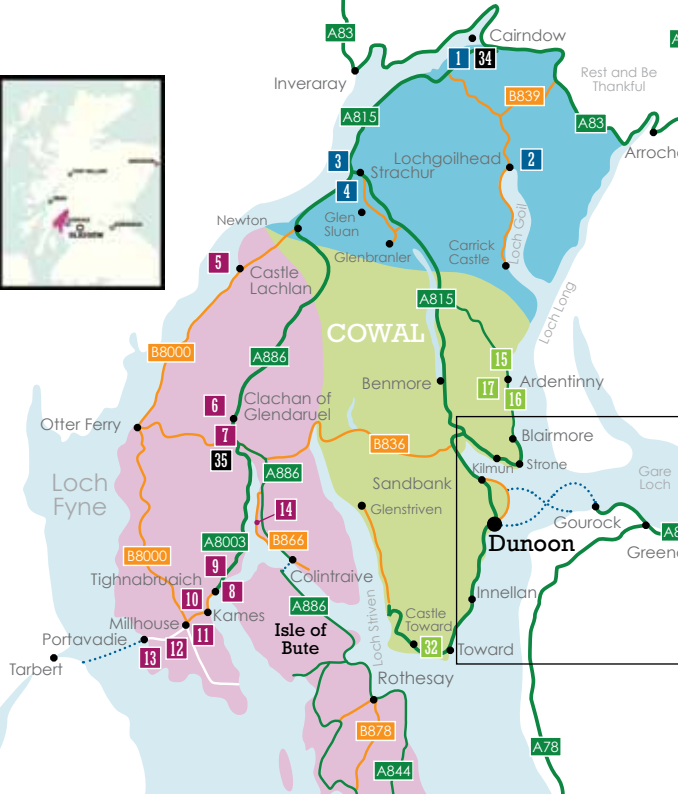
How to get here

By Car Ferry - From Gourrock, a mile past the town centre, Western Ferries run frequently to Hunter's Quay. Turn left for Dunoon or right for Kilmun, Strachur, etc. www.western-ferries.co.uk NB Calmac no longer take vehicles to Dunoon.

From Tarbert - Calmac ferry once an hour to Portavadie, in the south west of Cowal. Or from **Bute**, Calmac ferry from Rhodobach to Colintraive, every half hour. www.calmac.co.uk

By Road - From Glasgow, take A82 by Loch Lomond, A83 via Arrochar and the Rest and Be Thankful to Cairndow. A left turn for A815 takes you through the Cowal Peninsula towards Dunoon.

By Train - From Glasgow Central to Gourrock, where Argyll Ferries take foot passengers to Dunoon. www.argyllferries.co.uk



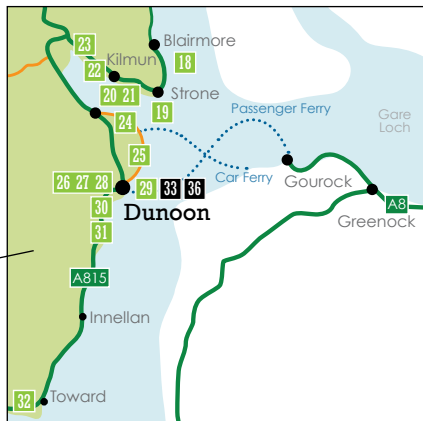

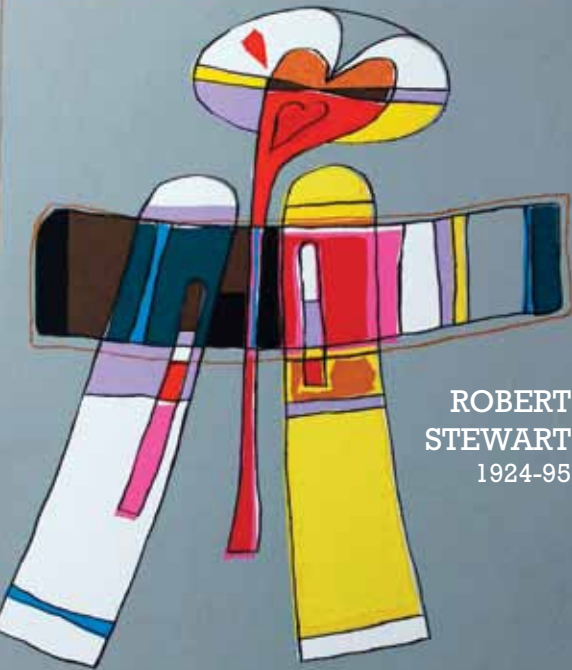

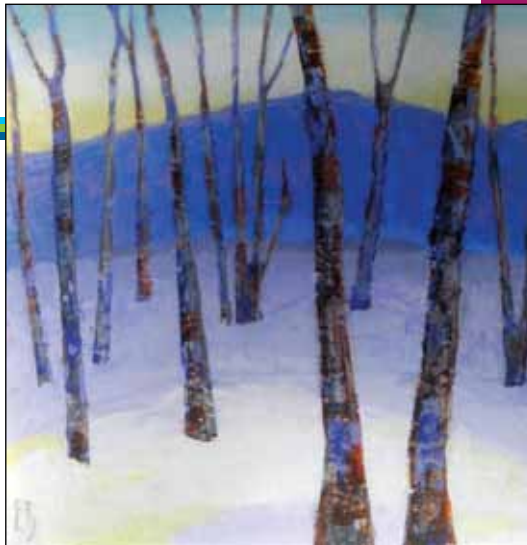
