HOW TO GET THER

BY CAR FERRY - From GOUROCK, a mile past the town centre, Western Ferries run a regular service to Hunter's Quay where you can then, turn left for west areas of Dunoon & Toward, or right for north and east Cowal to Klimun. Strachur etc.
