

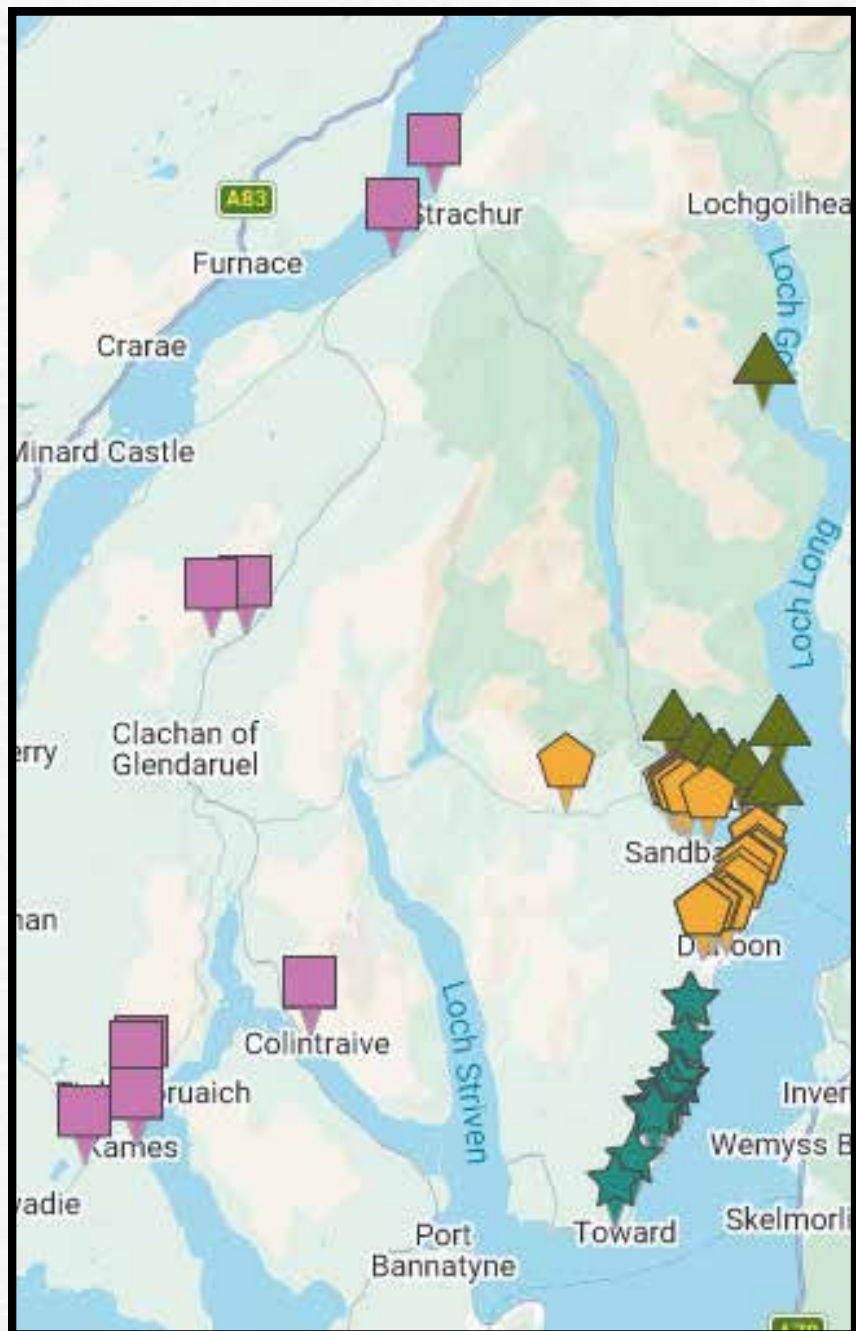

The ever popular event is known as the Cowal Open Studios Trail which is promoted with a guidebook showing you the location of each member's venue and a short bio so that you can plan your trail ahead of time.
